The U.S. Ambassador to Montenegro Her Excellency Margaret Ann Uyehara and her associates visited the Main Control-Measuring Center for control and monitoring of the radio-frequency spectrum in Dajbabska gora in Podgorica.

On that occasion, Zoran Sekulić, Executive Director of the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services, Darko Grgurović, the newly elected Executive Director, Boris Jevrić Assistant Executive Director for Wireless Communications and Predrag Perutić General Manager for Control and Monitoring of the Radio-Frequency Spectrum acquainted the guests from the Embassy with the work and responsibilities of the Agency as an independent regulatory body in the field of electronic communications and postal services, and made a presentation of the System for control and monitoring of the radio-frequency spectrum, with particular reference to architecture, building and the character of the facility in Dajbabska gora.

Executive Director of the Agency Zoran Sekulić highlighted, inter alia, continuous support that the Government of the United States has been providing to the Agency as of its foundation.
